Brief Explanation:

The University of California (UC) requires schools and/or districts to update their UC 'a–g' Course Lists annually to reflect the courses each site will offer the following school year. As in previous years, high schools' UC 'a–g' Course Lists will be updated centrally through a districtwide submission. Schools should not make changes to their individual site 'a–g' lists; these changes should instead be effected through the High School Resources Office.

Action: All district high schools with established UC 'a–g' Course Lists are asked to print, review, and complete the 2015–16 UC 'a–g' Course List update documents as described in Attachment 1 and return them by **Tuesday, May 26, 2015**, to Karen Wilson, Planning Analyst, High School Resources Office, Room 2005, Eugene Brucker Education Center. Please return your original marked-up copies of the printed update documents.

UPDATING THE UC ‘A-G’ COURSE LIST DOCUMENTS

Background:

The University of California requires high schools to update their UC ‘a-g’ Course Lists annually to accurately reflect the courses each school will offer during the school year in question. In the district, this update is done centrally on behalf of all high schools with the information provided on the attached course worksheets.

Action required:

Principals are asked to complete and return the following documents to Karen Wilson, Planning Analyst, High School Resources Office, Room 2005, Eugene Brucker Education Center, **by Tuesday, May 26, 2015:**

- ATTACHMENT 2—PRINCIPAL CERTIFICATION FORM
- ATTACHMENT 3—‘A-G’ COURSE WORKSHEETS (8 TOTAL)

General:

PRINCIPAL CERTIFICATION FORM: A signed Principal Certification Form must accompany the updated 2015-16 UC ‘a-g’ course worksheets when they are returned. Principals are responsible for the accuracy of the information reported on their school’s UC ‘a-g’ Course List every year; by signing the certification form, they acknowledge they have reviewed the updated course information and agree that it should be submitted as their school’s official 2015–16 UC ‘a-g’ Course List.

‘A-G’ COURSE WORKSHEETS: The seven subject-area (one for each ‘a-g’ subject) and two Advanced Placement (AP) course worksheets reflect schools’ 2014-15 ‘a-g’ course choices and must be updated for the 2015–16 school year by removing any courses that won’t be offered and adding those that will be new to the school next year. Schools’ UC ‘a-g’ Course Lists are intended as year-specific records of the course opportunities available to students at their individual high school sites, so accurately reporting your site’s viable course offerings each year is important.

Updating the Worksheets:

Print out all eight subject-category worksheets in Attachment 3. The first seven worksheets list courses in the individual ‘a-g’ subject areas (History, English, etc.); the eighth worksheet is a combined listing of Advanced Placement courses for all the subject areas.

All currently approved district UC ‘a-g’ courses are listed on the worksheets with the exception of online courses offered by iHigh Virtual Academy. Please do not add a course to a worksheet if you don’t see it; if it isn’t there, it doesn’t meet an ‘a-g’ requirement.

Update each worksheet, **using a blue or red pen** to record your changes, as follows:

a) ‘A-G’ SUBJECT-AREA COURSE WORKSHEETS (7 total):

1. Write the name of your school in the appropriate space at the top of each worksheet.
2. **Review and verify the courses currently assigned to your school on each worksheet.** These courses should match the ones that your school is offering this year, as well as the ones that are on your school’s published 2014-15 UC ‘a-g’ Course List at <http://www.ucop.edu/agguide/> (select the ‘A-G’ Course Lists option). If there are any discrepancies, please note them on the appropriate worksheet.

3. **Update the worksheets to reflect the courses your school will offer in 2015–16.** When no course changes are needed on a worksheet page, write “No Change” or “NC” at the top of the page and circle it. On the rest of the worksheet pages, record the course changes in the left margin next to the course number as described below:

To Add a course to your 2015-16 ‘a-g’ list, circle the course number and title and write ‘A’ in the margin next to it.

To Remove an assigned course so that it doesn’t appear on your 2015-16 UC list a-g list, cross out the course number and title, and write ‘D’ in the margin next to it.

b) ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) COURSE WORKSHEETS:

1. Write the name of your school at the top of each worksheet.
2. **Update the worksheets to reflect the AP courses your school will offer in 2015–16.**
Record all course changes in the left margin next to the course number as described below:
 - If Reauthorizing** an AP course that is being taught at your school this year for 2015-16, put an ‘R’ in the left-hand margin next to the course number.
 - If Adding** a new AP course (defined as any course not currently being taught at your site) in 2015–16, put an ‘N’ next to the course number. All AP courses that have been **Redesigned** for 2015-16 are considered new and require new course-syllabi approval from the AP Audit. They are:
 - AP European History
 - AP Physics 2: Algebra-Based
 - AP Art History

New UC Policy For AP Courses Effective With The 2015-16 Update Cycle

Starting this year, UC will add new AP courses to a school’s ‘a-g’ Course List only if they have received prior approval from the AP Audit. Previously, UC had allowed AP courses that were under audit review, but not formally approved, to be put on a school’s list. Now, all new AP courses will only be allowed onto a school’s list if they have a verified audit status of “Approved/Authorized.” To be approved in time to be put on a site’s 2015-15 UC a-g course list, all new AP courses must have successfully completed the AP Audit process by **September 15, 2015**. The AP Audit calendar below details the actions required and their associated deadlines.

AP COURSE AUDIT: REQUIRED ACTIONS AND DEADLINES

All AP courses must be approved and/or authorized annually through the College Board AP Audit to use the AP® trademark in connection with the course. It is the high school’s responsibility to ensure that teachers of new AP courses obtain audit approval for their syllabi and to annually renew audit authorization for AP teachers whose syllabi have already been approved. The AP Audit deadlines in effect for the College Board are different from the AP audit deadlines required by the UC for schools maintaining ‘a-g’ course lists. To be included on a school’s official 2015-16 UC ‘a-g’ Course List, AP courses **must be formally approved by the AP Audit by September 15, 2015**, as evidenced by **an official status listing of “Approved/Authorized,” or “Reauthorized,” in the school’s AP Audit Account.**

To ensure that AP courses meet the September 15 cutoff date, schools will need to adhere to the following deadlines:

March 3—June 30, 2015:

TEACHERS OF NEW AP COURSES COMPLETE AND SUBMIT THEIR SYLLABI FOR AUDIT REVIEW

To be included in the annual November ledger of approved AP courses, the College Board recommends that new course syllabi requiring audit authorization to be submitted to the audit site no later than June 30, 2015. That is also the recommended date by which syllabi should be submitted to meet the new UC deadline. The audit began accepting syllabi submission on March 3, 2015. Additional actions that need to be completed during this period include establishing the school's AP Course Audit Account for 2015-16, and finalizing the electronic Course Audit Forms that must be transmitted with teachers' new course submissions.

Principals also need to make sure that teachers meet the end-of-June deadline for their syllabi submission. All syllabi submissions should reflect the district-adopted textbook for the course unless the school has applied for and received an Instructional Materials Waiver. Principals are responsible for making sure that teachers don't submit a sample syllabus from the College Board's AP website if it specifies a textbook that has not been approved by the district.

August 1— September 15, 2015:

PRINCIPALS RENEW EXISTING AP TEACHERS' COURSE AUDIT AUTHORIZATIONS

Principals renew the existing audit authorizations of AP teachers who will continue at their school in 2015-16, and remove those who won't be continuing their courses at the school next year. The audit begins accepting renewal requests starting August 1, and it is recommended that schools start this reauthorization process as early in August as possible.

September 15— January 31, 2016:

UC 'A-G' UPDATE CYCLE CLOSES

AP teachers from 2014-15 who are no longer teaching their courses at the school in 2015-16 must have their names removed from the school's 2015-16 AP Audit Account. This can only be done by calling the AP Audit Helpline at 877 APHELP-0. The final audit approval date for all AP courses that are being taught in the 2015-16 school year, as set by the College Board, is January 31, 2016. Schools whose AP courses did not get audit approved in time to make the UC Course List deadline are still required to obtain AP Audit approval to use the registered AP trademark in their title. Courses that have not received audit approval by this date will be required to remove the AP designation from their course title.
